

Master of Human Resources Management (MHRM)

- 18-24 months long master programs offered to individuals who are interested in pursuing and further developing their managerial profession in the Human Resources field.
- Students meet for classes over the semester during 3 Hours/3day a week on evenings.
- Students have the option to earn a postgraduate diploma from Washington State University where the WSU courses are embedded into the regular MHRM curriculum.
- WSU professors fly to Riyadh every semester to provide students the option to earn a postgraduate diploma in one of the following disciplines:
